We feel this problem was due to:

Heavy rainfall events at the end of the month caused the spike in TSS and C-BOD₅. The average flow during the last week of January was 23.37MGD. The plant is permitted for 12MGD.

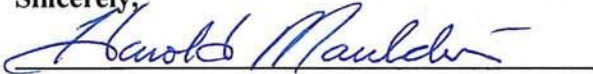
We plan on correcting the problem in this manner:

Construction is set to begin on new secondary and upgrades to secondary clarification will aid in the event of high flows.

Time estimated that it will take to correct problem:

When flows decrease, the TSS and C-BOD issues will decrease as well. All other permit parameters were within acceptable range.
